

Great savings continue on Malarone

There are no such restrictions in the US, and many people worldwide use Malarone for several years without reported adverse effects. At InterHealth we will supply up to 6 months of Malarone at a time, if appropriate.

2. No trip to your GP and no postage delays

InterHealth is a non-NHS clinic, and as we are not a retail pharmacy we can dispense Malarone worldwide based on the recommendation of one of our InterHealth Clinicians.

This means;

- no GP private prescription charges
- no time out to visit GP
- no postage delays for sending in to online pharmacy

3. Order medicines for up to 6 colleagues online

Our new online TravelShop makes it much easier to order medicines and all your essentials for global travel online. You can buy medicines (including Malarone) for 1-6 individuals per order. If you need to order for more people please contact the Travel Supplies team on 020 7902 9000. If you are an individual subscriber, you cannot order medicines on behalf of a group. Only those with an organisation subscription can order for a group.
