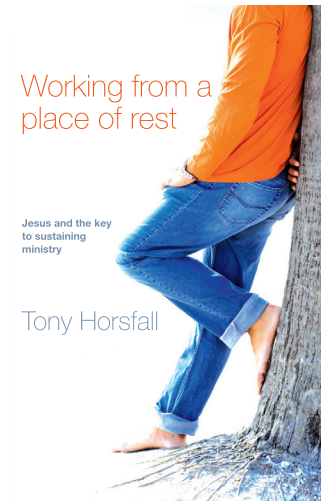
Special Book Launch
