Before you travel

Don't let a nasty tropical disease get in the way of your volunteering and adventure travel. Every year nearly 500,000 individuals of all ages undertake short-term projects and expeditions with a range of organisations. They assist in diverse assignments in some of the world's poorest countries and explore some of the most exciting parts of the world!

You may be travelling to a country with high risks to both your health and security. Perhaps the project you are working in puts you at risk of malaria, dengue fever or TB?

Our specialist Travel Clinic is located in central London and runs a vaccination and traveladviceserviceforshort-termandlongterm travellers and volunteers going abroad.



All vaccinations are available from InterHealth and we are able to provide individuals with up-to-the minute recommendations on vaccines and antimalarials from our specialist travel health databases. We are also a World Health Organisation recognised centre for Yellow Fever vaccination.

In your consultation an InterHealth nurse will give you specific recommendations about what vaccinations you need for your trip and how you can prevent malaria

and other tropical illnesses, including how to avoid the biggest nuisance of all – Diarrhoea. This consultation is free if you join the TravelWell Plan for one year at just £50 per person.

Although most people return home well and without problems, you can never be sure. Did you know that about HALF of all swimmers in Lake Malawi test positive for Bilharzia when checked at InterHealth or other tropical centres? You can contract Bilharzia and feel entirely well for the first few months without any symptoms at all!

Returners Medical Check-Up

The consultation screens for diseases you may have been exposed to. As well as giving you and your family peace of mind it enables our doctors to identify any issues before they become problematic. The appointment includes key tests such as a red and white blood cell count and a stool test for parasites. Bilharzia if you may have been exposed.
